The question is frequently asked by users. Hair Transplantation is the process of transplanting healthy hair follicles using microsurgical methods to areas where hair follicles are no longer active and balding occurs. In hair transplantation, the patient's own healthy hair is added to the lost area. Hair transplantation is planned and implemented completely individually.

During the hair transplantation operation, hair follicles that are resistant to loss, usually in the nape of the patient's neck, are collected and transplanted into the channels opened in the areas where there is thinning or complete hair loss.

How is Hair Transplanted?



Designing

In practice, hair follicles are generally taken from the nape of the neck and transplanted to the targeted bald area. These taken hair follicles are called grafts.



ocal nestha The application takes a **few hours depending on the amount of hair loss.** If the balding area is very large, several sessions may be required to complete the treatment.



Harvest from Donor Area

Generally, the intervention is performed under **Local Anesthesia**. Rarely, hair transplantation can be performed by putting patients to sleep under a procedure we call **sedation**.



Hair Transplant After hair transplantation, a special bandage is applied to the harvested part. In the first days after hair transplantation, the medications to be used and the necessary information are given and the patients are discharged immediately after the procedure.



Final Result The bandage is removed on the 1st or 2nd day after hair transplantation and patients can then return to their daily lives. Patients get rid of the crusts within 7-10 days after the hair transplantation procedure and completely return to their pre-transplantation state.

Frequently Asked Questions

What happens after the surgery?

It is important to follow the post-operative instructions provided by your surgeon to ensure optimal healing and hair growth. This may include avoiding certain activities or products, taking prescribed medications, and attending follow-up appointments. Patients may experience some temporary side effects such as swelling, scabbing, itching, and numbness, which typically resolve within a few weeks to a few months. Follow-up visits are important for monitoring progress and assessing the results of the procedure.

Are there any complications from surgery?

Some potential complications of hair transplant surgery may include bleeding, infection, scarring, poor hair growth or unnatural-looking results, swelling, itching, numbness, and shock loss.

Will my transplanted hair eventually fall out?

Yes, the transplanted hair is generally permanent and is not expected to fall out. The transplanted hair follicles are taken from areas of the scalp that are genetically resistant to balding and are therefore unlikely to fall out in the future.

Does the procedure hurt?

To clarify further, local anesthesia is used to numb the area where hair follicles are extracted and transplanted, so you won't feel any pain during the surgery. Intravenous sedation may also be used to help you relax and feel more comfortable during the procedure.

Will I be able to swim and enjoy other physical activities with my new hair?

Yes, you should be able to swim and participate in physical activities with your new hair after a short recovery period like 1 month. The transplanted hair is permanent and can be washed, cut, and dyed like your natural hair.
